

Tenets of Academic research and Ethics education Curriculum at National Tsing Hua University

Adopted at the first school curriculum committee meeting in the 102 academic year on December 5, 102.

Revised at the first school curriculum committee meeting in the 103 academic year on October 9, 103.

Approved at the first academic conference of the 103 academic year on October 16, 103.

1. In order to improve the research ethics of master's and doctoral students, National Tsing Hua University has specifically formulated the "National Tsing Hua University: Tenets of university academic research ethics education course" (Hereinafter referred to as this course).
2. Master's and doctoral students enrolled in the 104 academic year onwards must take the above-mentioned ethics education course in their first academic year.
3. This course is offered through online teaching and is a compulsory course with 0 credits. All students who take this course must meet the passing standard set for the course; those who fail, must retake and pass the test before applying for the degree exam. Students who have not completed this course are not allowed to apply for the degree exam.
4. The above points take effect after approval by the school curriculum committee and approval by the academic affairs meeting.
