National Tsing Hua University Department of Economics Master's thesis examination

- 1. This is formulated in accordance with the regulations of thesis examination of National Tsing Hua University.
- Graduate students of the master's degree program in Economics may complete the oral examination only after completing the required subjects with the required passing grades. The thesis proposal should have been submitted at least six months before the oral examination day.
- 3. The advisor must be a full-time faculty member of the department and at least join the faculty of the department after the graduate student completes the first draft of the thesis. The advisor and another faculty member approved by the department head will form the review team to review the first draft of the paper.
- 4. After the graduate student completes the first draft of the paper, the following documents must be submitted:
 - a. Past transcripts
 - b. Draft of the paper and its abstract
 - c. Recommendation letter from the advisor

With the approval of the department head, the application is sent to the Academic Affairs Office for approval as a master's degree candidate.

- 5. The review of the first draft of the paper can be held one month before the oral test day and the student will present it in the form of a public report. The review team should submit the first draft review without one week after reviewing it.
- 6. The graduate student should correct the content of the first draft or provide an explanation main acceptable to the review team according to the points mentioned in the review opinion of the first draft of the paper, and complete the first draft of the paper.
- 7. In accordance with the regulations of the thesis oral examination, the thesis advisor shall choose faculty members to form the thesis

examination committee and decide together when the examination will be held.

- 8. Those who fail the oral test may apply for re-examination in the next semester, and the re-examination is limited to one time.
- 9. The following is a tentative timeline for the master thesis:
 - Submit a tentative thesis proposal on November 10
 - Submit a definitive thesis proposal before December 1st
 - Complete the first draft of the paper before April 20
 - Review of the first draft of the paper on May 10
 - Complete the original paper on May 20
 - Take the thesis oral examination on July 20
